Wands for Wildlife

Did you know that your mascara typically lasts around three months? If you're unsure when you started using it, watch out for signs like the formula drying out, clumping, or developing an unusual smell. If these occur before three months, avoid pumping the mascara wand in and out, which can introduce more bacteria into the tube. Since preservatives have a limited lifespan, consider getting a new mascara and send the used wand to Miss AMS for recycling to support wildlife. You can drop off used mascara wands in the collection box at the café. This is a recycling events so please do not



Please SAVE and COLLECT *USED* mascara wands. Miss AMS will be collecting the wands, cleaning them, and sending them to the Appalachian Wildlife Refuge for their Wands for Wildlife program.

RECYCLE & SAVE WILD LIVES!

Old mascara wands are used to clean and remove fly eggs and larva from the fur of wild animals. They work great because the bristles are close together.

Please bring in used mascara wands in bags. There will be a collection bin located in the café. This program is to recycle, so please do not purchase disposable wands, and to help animals.
